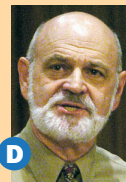
Scott M. Matheson Jr.

Van Dam wins with 97 percent delegate support over Cody Judy (3 percent), and faces Republican incumbent Robert Bennett in November.

1st DISTRICT

Thompson avoids a primary with 63 percent support, but Brian Watkins makes a surprising showing with 37 percent. Thompson and Bishop, the first-term GOP incumbent, face off in November.

2nd DISTRICT

Bridgewater (54 percent) and Swallow (46 percent) head to their second primary in two years as David Wilde is eliminated in convention. The winner faces two-term incumbent Democrat Matheson in November.

3rd DISTRICT

With Greg Hawkins eliminated in convention, four-term incumbent Cannon (58 percent) faces a primary challenge from Throckmorton (42 percent) in June for the GOP nomination. The winner goes against Democrat Babka in November.
